Special Notes and General Rules:

1. No Santa allowed. He will be provided by the Unity Group
2. Horse groups must provide cleanup for their animals
3. Any injury resulting from the throwing of candy from units will be the responsibility of the parties throwing it.
4. You will receive an entry number placard. You need to place this number in you window upon arriving at the beginning of the parade route.
5. Please maintain at least **50** foot buffer from the float or unit in front of you!
6. **KEEP YOUR GROUP TOGETHER!! ALL CHILDREN MUST HAVE ADULT SUPERVISION AT ALL TIME!! NO EXCEPTIONS>>THANK YOU and BE SAFE!!**

7. Motorized Vehicle Participant Rules

Any individuals operating a motorized vehicle will adhere to the following guidelines as set forth by the Chief of Police for the Leland Police Department.

1. No rapid acceleration or deceleration maneuvers
2. No spinning or burning of tires
3. No wheelie or acrobatic type maneuvers
4. No hands free steering of vehicle

These rules are placed into effect as a matter of public safety. Any violations noted during the parade will subject the operator to possible charges of careless or reckless operation of a vehicle.

8. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed during the parade.
9. No pets or animals allowed on the float.
10. No one under 18 years old may drive a float in the parade
11. Please ---no continuous blowing of sirens and horns while in the parade.
